


Tallinn Literary Centre

- Tallinn Literary Centre concentrates on the legacy of two of the foremost Estonian writers: A.H. Tammsaare and Eduard Vilde. We are responsible for administrating Tammsaare and Vilde museums and we take an active part in Tallinn literary life.

- Our dream is to make literature more visible in Tallinn city landscape and to ensure that the literature heritage of Tallinn is well preserved.
